The Lord showed David Wilkerson, the founder of Teen Challenge drug abuse rehabilitation centers, the future's bad news, but countered it with five words of hope:

As I started driving home in a bad section of our town, a man walking down the alley stopped me to ask for something to eat. He was so hungry he had smoked some cocaine to dull his hunger. He had just gotten out of nine months in prison where he had been involved in a gang fight. He was certain he never wanted to go there again.

I told him he needed to do two things. First, put Jesus Christ in the driver's seat of his life. Second, find a church of ex-addicts, like the Power of God church next to the bowling alley, as a support system.

I fed him, but first led him to the side window of our ministry print shop where the small *Know Your Future* booklet had been enlarged to fit on two posters. I pointed to the World's Most Important Prayer on page twelve, and he began to read it out loud without my prompting. I laid a hand on his shoulder and prayed. He said he felt a change as Jesus, and God the Holy Spirit, came into his heart, cleansed his soul, writing his name in the Heavenly city's registry - the Book of Life.

Peter, a disciple of Jesus Christ, warns us to prepare ourselves for the days ahead:

The Lord isn't really being slow about His promise, as some people think. No, He is being patient for your sake. He does not want anyone to be destroyed, but wants everyone to repent.

But the day of the Lord will come unexpectedly as a thief. Then the heavens will pass away

with a terrible noise, and the very elements themselves will disappear in fire, and the earth and everything on it will be found to deserve judgment.

Since everything around us is going to be destroyed like this, what holy and godly lives you should live, looking forward to the day of God and hurrying it along. On that day, He will set the heavens on fire, and the elements will melt away in the flames.

But we are looking forward to the new heavens and new earth He has promised, a world filled with God's righteousness.
