and Gomorrah. In Luke 17, Jesus compares the condition of the world during Noah's time and during Lot's time to that of the world just prior to the Second Coming of Christ.

Jesus warns us of the soon-coming "sudden destruction" upon this earth in Luke 17:26-28. The Living Bible reads, "When I return, the world will be as indifferent to the things of God as the people were in Noah's day. They ate and drank and married—everything just as usual right up to the day when Noah went into the ark and the flood came and destroyed them all. And the world will be as it was in the days of Lot: people went about their daily business—eating and drinking, buying and selling, farming and building—until the morning Lot left Sodom. Then fire and brimstone rained down from heaven and destroyed them all. Yes, it will be business as usual, right up to the hour of my return."

The comparisons between the days of Noah and Lot and the current sinful conditions in the world are many. The results will be the same—sudden destruction! For those that have made Christ the Lord and Saviour of their lives, there is a great escape coming—the Rapture of the Church. (I Thessalonians 4:13-18) You do not have to go through this horrible catastrophic, destructive time known as the seven-year Tribulation, which is going to strike this earth very, very soon now. Jesus is our Blessed Hope.

I Thessalonians 5:9 says, "For God has not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ." You can obtain salvation by putting your faith in Jesus Christ and making Him the Lord of your life. A peace beyond human comprehension can be yours. An eternal home in heaven can be yours. Dear Father God,


